



Notice of UK Parliamentary General Election for the Midlothian County Constituency

Thursday 4 July 2024

1. An election is to be held for the return of a Member of Parliament to serve Midlothian County Constituency.
2. Nomination papers may be obtained at the place and times below. The Returning Officer will at the request of any elector prepare for signature a nomination paper.
3. Nomination Papers must be delivered by the candidate or his/her proposer or seconder (or Election Agent if name and address previously given) to the Returning Officer at the Election Office, Midlothian Council, Midlothian House, Buccleuch Street, Dalkeith, Midlothian EH22 1DN on any date after the date of this Notice, Monday to Friday between 10 am and 4 pm but not later than 4.00 pm, on Friday 7 June 2024.
4. The £500 deposit can be paid by legal tender or by means of a banker's draft from a drawer which carries on business as a banker in the United Kingdom. Payment may also be made by debit or credit card or by the electronic transfer of funds which should be pre-authorized by the Returning Officer
5. If the election is contested, the poll will take place between the hours of 7 am and 10 pm on Thursday 4 July 2024.
6. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 12 midnight on Tuesday 18 June 2024.
7. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer, 17A South Gyle Crescent, Edinburgh EH12 9FL or Midlothian House, Buccleuch Street, Dalkeith, Midlothian EH22 1DN by 5.00 pm on Wednesday 19 June 2024.
8. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Elector's Document valid for this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5.00pm on Wednesday 26 June 2024. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate can be made online: www.gov.uk/apply-for-photo-id-to-vote .
9. Applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer, 17A South Gyle Crescent, Edinburgh EH12 9FL by 5.00 pm on Wednesday 26 June 2024.
10. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer, 17A South Gyle Crescent, Edinburgh EH12 9FL by 5.00 pm on Thursday 4 July 2024.
